EXISTING HOT SPOT DEVICE

Does your phone have Hotspot access?

T-Mobile is helping by:

- Removing smartphone data caps for all customers
- Giving 20GB of additional mobile hotspot data
- Increasing data for schools in our EmpowerED program
- Making it free to call severely impacted countries

Sprint is helping by:

- Customers with metered data plans will receive unlimited data per month for 60 days (a minimum of 2 billing cycles) at no extra cost.
- Customers will be provided an additional 20GB of mobile hotspot data per month for 60 days (a minimum of 2 billing cycles)
- Customers with mobile hotspot-capable handsets who don't have mobile hotspot will now get 20GB as well per month for 60 days (a minimum of 2 billing cycles) at no extra cost.



EXISTING INTERNET CONNECTION

Do you have Wi-Fi at home? This is typically available through your cable provider. Locally, it is Spectrum.

If so, you are ready for virtual learning.



SPECTRUM WIFI

Charter will offer free Spectrum broadband and Wi-Fi access for 60 days. To enroll call 1-844-488-8395. Installation fees will be waived for new student households.

Household must have a k-12 and/or college student who does not already have a spectrum broadband subscription at any service level up to 100 Mbps.

SPECTRUM INTERNET ASSIST

Spectrum Internet Assist
Spectrum will offer a Free Internet modem, high-speed Internet at 30 Mbps., no data caps, no contracts, optional in-home Wi-Fi service at \$5/mo. To enroll, complete the [application](#) and submit required [documentation](#).

One or more members of your household must be a recipient of one of the following assistance programs:

- National School Lunch Program (NSLP)
- Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) of the NSLP
- Supplemental Security Income (for applicants age 65+ only)
