

## SHAC Meeting Minutes

Date: September 27<sup>th</sup>, 2017 @ 12 Noon

Location: Smithville Elementary Teachers Lunch Room

All attendees were asked to introduce themselves and the entity they represented.

### **Old Business:**

Sophie Weinheimer discussed missing minutes from the 02/15/2017 meeting. Debra Rose stated that she has notes from the meeting and will present minutes at the next SHAC meeting for approval.

Minutes were reviewed from 04/12/2017. Candy Biehle made a motion to approve the minutes as read. The motion was seconded by Deborah Rose and carried unanimously.

### **New Business:**

- Tobacco Prevention: Sharlene Scheler was asked by SHAC to present the tobacco prevention program to Smithville Elementary school. The dates will be coordinated through Sophie Weinheimer.
- Employee Wellness: Walgreens and the Wesley Nurse- Sharlene Scheler administered over 100 flu/Tdap immunizations to the SISD staff members. They also administered over 100 vaccines for the Smithville community.
- Drug Awareness: Sharlene Scheler has coordinated the national drug take back day on October 28<sup>th</sup> at Smithville City Hall.
- Hurricane Harvey Flood victims: Sharlene Scheler has received a 1,000 dollar grant to use for flood victims of the Smithville Community. She has reached out to the principals of SISD to get individual names of victims affected by the flood to assist in their aid.
- Abstinence Program: Celeste Hoffman from Bastrop Pregnancy Resource Center presented to SHAC the information on the WAIT and Worth the WAIT abstinence program. The plan is to present the information to the Superintendent to assess if the program meets the criteria. Once approval has been granted the SHAC will meet again to vote on which abstinence program will be used. Sophie Weinheimer will schedule that meeting within the next month. The Bastrop Pregnancy Resource Center is a resource for pregnant individuals offering free pregnancy testing; educational skills for prenatal and post natal care; counseling; and various support groups. The school nurse at each SISD campus has received pamphlets and business cards.
- Community Wellness: Jill Strube from the City of Smithville reported that the National Walk to School Wednesday will start on October 4' 2017; she encouraged all schools to participate. - SISD Child Nutrition: Candy Biehle reported the success of the Summer Feeding Program who fed over 8,000 meals over the course of the summer at various locations throughout the city of Smithville. She was informed that parents do get extra food stamp benefits through the summer months. A new addition to the Summer Feeding Program was a smoothie bar set up at the Smithville Public Library and Smithville Recreation Center, which showed to have great success.
