Dancing! Music! Games! Prizes! Dance Contest! Minute-to-Win-It! Prizes! Give aways!

The American Heart Association and MMSSA are hosting the Have a Heart Dance Party! All entry proceeds will go to the American Heart Association so they can continue their research on heart disease, as well as assist families who have loved ones suffering from heart disease or ailments.

The entry fee is \$5.00 per student which includes entry, dance music (no DJ), games, a dance contest, Minute to Win It Challenges, prizes for winners, and non-uniform attire just for this event. A permission form is required along with the \$5 entry fee. There will be refreshments **available for purchase** in the café. No backpacks, bags or water bottles or flasks will be allowed in the café during the dance party. Leave all belongings in Advisory classrooms.

Café doors will close at 12:55 PM and no one will be allowed to enter after that time. No refund will be given for any reason, including absences and late shows, since all money will have already been donated to the American Heart Association.

The event is limited to 300 students, and the list will be filled on a first-in, first-on basis as forms are turned in **to Mrs. Villa** (not to Advisory teachers). The deadline for forms and money is Monday, Feb. 25. Permission forms are available from Advisory teachers or on the school website. Bring forms to the SG room during available hours. To participate, students must have passing grades in all core subjects (no Fs) and cannot have any outstanding obligations with the school.

Dress Code for Dance Party: Participating students will be allowed to change after 12:35 PM.

NOTE: The dance party will have a Glow-in-the-Dark décor, so the committee encourages WHITE or neon tops or bottoms.

1. Tops: Any top that covers the entire shoulder, chest, back and midriff. No sheer/see-through fabrics. Can be any color; can have long or short sleeves. Wording or graphics must be school appropriate.
2. Bottoms: Long pants or shorts in any color, including stripes of any width. Shorts must have an inseam of at least 4 inches. Ripped or “peek-a-boo” jeans are okay as long as the openings are not located above mid-thigh all around. Wording or graphics must be school appropriate. No sheer/see-through fabrics. No leggings or other skin-tight bottoms.
3. Outerwear: The café will be warm during the dance party, so outerwear will not be necessary. Therefore, all outerwear must still adhere to the uniform policy.
4. Footwear – Normal school footwear is advised. No heels or sole heights above 2 inches.

Behavior: This is a school activity and students are expected to behave appropriately. If a student is being disrespectful to other students or insubordinate to event chaperones, the student will be removed from the dance party, and will sit outside under adult supervision for the remainder of the event.
