

**MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL MEETING OF THE

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE: The Pledge of Allegiance was said.

NEW BUSINESS:

- A. Mrs. Greenwood acting as ex officio committee member, asked the committee members to introduce themselves and state if they were a staff or community member.
- B. Mrs. Greenwood acting as ex officio committee member, stated that the purpose of this committee is to provide the Governing Board with a different point of view in regards to the candidates for the superintendent search. She explained the process and provided each committee member with a page of questions for each candidate and a score sheet.
- C. Mr. Steve Highlen, Arizona School Boards Association representative, explained Arizona open meeting law to the committee members and answered questions.
