Women's History Month feature- Susan B. Anthony and Elizabeth Cady Stanton formed the National Woman Suffrage Association and worked to get voting rights for women. In 1872, Anthony voted, even though it was against the law. She was arrested and fined for voting. In 1920, 14 years after she died, women in the United States won the right to vote. Susan B. Anthony was the first real woman printed on U.S. currency.
