If you have a student in the grades above, he/she will take the SBAC test this month.
 What is the SBAC?

With new state standards, students are working harder, thinking more critically, and applying their learning to the real world. To measure these new standards, educators worked together to develop new, high-quality tests in English and math for grades 3–8 and high school.

It is important that your child be prepared for the test each day:

- **Be on time-** late students will be placed in a classroom not testing and will need to complete the assessment in the “test make-up” room at a later date. It is much better to test with their own teacher and classmates.
- **Eat Breakfast-** studies show that students perform better when they have had breakfast!
- **Get plenty of sleep-** Students need an average of 10 hours of sleep per night.
- **Do your best!**
