Parents/guardians of returning students completing the registration process **including completing the residency form and providing the necessary documents** before Friday, June 29, will be eligible for an early registration fee of \$50 per student.

All parents/guardians are required to complete the residency form and provide the necessary documentation to be considered enrolled for the 2018-2019 school year.

Parents/Guardians qualifying for free and reduce lunch registration fees during this school year, will need to complete a *School Fee Waiver Form* for the 2018-2019 School Year.
