2019 ICD Fish Fry

REQUIREMENTS:

1. Each family (a parent) will be required to work one shift.
 - a. Actual job will be assigned when you arrive for your shift.
 - Be prepared to work anywhere for your location!
 - Dress appropriately.
 - b. If a family fails to work a shift, a \$100.00 fine will be placed on your school account.

TUITION RAFFLE:

2. Tuition Raffle - For each shift worked, the family name will be entered into a drawing for one year of free tuition for one child. The free tuition drawing entry will only be given to the ICD parents. Parents may not have students, children, parishioners, or other people work in place of their scheduled shift to receive the ticket.
 - a. The drawing will take place and announced at the last HSO meeting of the year.
 - b. Raffle ticket will be distributed at the end of the shift.

DATES:

3. Fish Fry Volunteer Dates are as follows:
 - Week of March 4th
 - Week of March 11th
 - Week of March 18th
 - Week of March 25th
 - Week of April 1st
 - Week of April 8th

SIGN UPS:

 - Drive Thru:
 - Possible work assignment:
 - a. Drive thru/Outside Order taker/Cashier/Plating orders
 - Fry House:
 - Possible work assignment:
 - a. Bread Fish/Fry Fish/Runner
- b. Closers – Clean Up
 - Tables/Kitchen/Dining Room/Dishes/Bathroom/etc
- c. Closers – Fry House

4. Final assignments will be published in the Window on February 22nd.

****PLEASE NOTE****

5. If you have signed up to receive the food truck, please take into account that the arrival time can vary with weather, traffic, and prior stops.
6. There are **8 available slots** for service hours per week for 8th grade students and high school students. Students must sign up/schedule their service hour shifts. Students must see their assigned crew captain for signature on service hours obtained at end of shift. New this year – separate link for student sign ups.
7. If more than one person is accessing the same shift at the same time, the person who submits their information first will be entered on that record. In this situation, it is possible to see your name appear on the shift but your information may not have been stored. **YOU MUST** log off of the website and log back on in order to check that your information was accepted for the shift you requested. Thank you for your patience.
