

A TSI test administered on November 27 in the Media Center Computer Lab. The TSI test determines the appropriate level of college course work. It consists of three exams: math, reading, and writing. Students planning to attend a university or community college in Texas must take the TSI unless they qualify for an exemption.

Seniors must register for the TSI test **by Nov. 26** on the following link:

The cost is free for students taking it for the first time and \$12 per section if retesting.

Students must **provide proof of completion of Go FAAR Modules and the Pre-Assessment Activity to Ms. Sandoval or Ms. DeHoyos prior to taking the TSI.**

- For students attending a local community college, the Go FAAR modules and Pre-Assessment activity is located on the ACES account.
- For students attending a 4 year university in TX, the Pre-Assessment activity is typically located on the universities Assessment or Testing link. Complete the Pre-Assessment Activity and print a copy of certificate of completion.

Are you exempt from the TSI exam?

- A minimum score of 530 on the SAT Math test is required for a TSI exemption in math
- A minimum score of 480 on the SAT Evidence –Based Reading & Writing (EBRW) is required for a TSI exemption in both reading and writing

ACT:

- Minimum composite score of 23 with:
- Atleast 19 on math for an exemption in math
- Atleast 19 on English for an exemption in reading and writing
