

## **Game Manager Duties**

Welcome Visiting Team (Usually will be done by the Head Coach)

Escort them to locker rooms; explain where their bench will be

Welcome Officials

Introduce yourself to the referees

Escort them to athletic office and court-before, at half, and at the end of game

Water and snacks provided in the athletic office. (Refrigerator)

Make sure ticket taker is present and understands their responsibility

Adults: \$4

Students: \$3 (NEWLHS students and NEWLHS alumni who are currently in college are free)

Grade school aged students are free

Blue Packerland Conference Pass admits 1 plus a guest. (regular season only, not WIAA tournament games)

Gold Senior Citizen Lifetime pass. Admits 1

During Contest-walk around and make your presence, make sure you are available for referees if they need crowd control.

Check in with Concessions to see if they are doing alright.

Half time of varsity game, be sure the Admissions person counts out money bag and puts into office safe (under office counter).

End of game, make sure referees get to the locker room safely.

### **Packerland Conference Regulations**

1. Conference regulations prohibit the following at athletic contests:
  - a. Stomping and heel kicking of bleachers.
  - b. Throwing of confetti.
  - c. Use of noisemakers unless used in conjunction with a bona fide school cheer and/or as part of a school's pep song being led by cheerleaders. Megaphones will not be allowed.
2. Visiting schools shall conform to any host school's policies and regulations not listed above.
3. The visiting chaperones are to introduce themselves to the host school supervisor in an effort to establish a close cooperation for dealing with crowd control problems at athletic events.
4. All chaperones are to assume an active role in assisting the host school in crowd control.
