## Certified Nursing Assistant

You can become a Certified Nursing Assistant in Illinois, then go on to a Nursing Program. The CNA program begins in January 2020 on the Moraine Valley campus, with lecture and lab sessions Monday through Thursday from 1 to 3:15 p.m., along with five clinical sessions on Saturdays from 6:30 a.m. to 3 p.m. Students are responsible for transportation to Moraine Valley and clinical sites. Successful completers will receive seven college credits and qualify for the State Competency Exam in June 2020. Moraine Valley's Basic Nurse Assistant Training Program is approved by the Illinois Department of Public Health.
