

The 'Badges for Life' blood drive will be held at Berrien County Elementary School. Appointments are encouraged, but walk-ins are always welcome. Blood donors receive a free Badges for Life T-shirt and a wellness check-up of blood pressure, pulse, temperature and iron count, including a cholesterol screening.

The need for blood is ongoing, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. During emergencies blood donors join our first responders in helping to save lives.
