## ACADEMIC PROFILE 2018-2019

Immaculate Conception High School follows a modified 4x4 block schedule with a Day 1/Day 2 rotation. All courses are taken as semester courses with the exception of Math and English for freshmen through juniors, which are scheduled for the entire year. Students taking Math and English all year, take five 80-minute courses each academic semester for a total of 8 courses each year. Classes are held Monday through Friday, on a two day cycle which only effects the Math and English course rotation. A student receives five credits for a full year core class and 6 credits for all laboratory based Science courses. The required program of study is college preparatory; every student who graduates will have taken all the units necessary for her admission to college.

## Felician University Collegiate Academy

Collegiate Academy gives eligible juniors and seniors the opportunity to earn college credits by successfully completing courses at Felician University on the Lodi and Rutherford Campuses.

Dual Enrollment College Courses DO NOT fulfill high school graduation requirements. Students entered in this program must be approved and maintain a minimum 3.0 GPA.
