**Registration begins:** Monday, February 25<sup>th</sup> at Nutrition

**Registration ends:** Friday, March 8<sup>th</sup> at 3:30 pm

### **REGISTRATION PAYMENTS:**

**High School Guidance Office:** To register for AP exams in person, students must present their student ID and pay in full with credit card, check or cash at the High School Guidance Office window. The Guidance Office window will be open during nutrition, lunch and afterschool.

**Online:** Online credit card registration payments are available by visiting the High School Web Store via the CCHS homepage: "Centaur Pro-Shop". Students must log in individually to register for exams. Make sure to print your receipt. **Please note that fee reductions are not available online.**

### **FEE REDUCTIONS**

#### **FREE & REDUCED LUNCH PROGRAM:**

If you are enrolled in the free/reduced lunch program, you automatically qualify for a fee reduction. ***In order to receive this reduction you must provide the current (18-19) food services verification letter stating you participate in the free/reduced program at the time of exam purchase.*** To obtain this letter you must go to the Food Services bungalow next to the cafeteria to request it. **Processing of this request may take up to 48 hours.** Do not wait until the last day. With this reduction, the exam cost is \$5/exam.

#### **REIMBURSEMENT PROGRAM APPLICATION:**

If you are not enrolled in free/reduced lunch, review the [AP Exam Fee Reduction Eligibility Chart](#) on the back of this letter to determine if you qualify for a fee reduction. If you believe you qualify, please see Ms. Magallanes for the Reimbursement Program Application. **You will need a copy of the 1<sup>ST</sup> page of your parent's 1040 Federal Tax Form.**

#### **SUPPLEMENTAL FEE REDUCTION APPLICATION:**

Students who do not qualify for the Reimbursement Program and are facing financial hardships should see Ms. Magallanes in the Guidance Office for a Supplemental Fee Reduction Application. All students are potentially eligible regardless of parent's income. Students should request applications during the first week of AP exam registration. **You will need a copy of the 1<sup>ST</sup> page of your parent's 1040 Federal Tax Form.**
