- Provides, as appropriate, direct and indirect psychological interventions to facilitate the functioning of individual and groups, such as developing, implementing and monitoring behavioral management strategies, providing group and individual counseling, designing intervention programs to enhance cognitive, affective, social, and vocational development in the school environment

- Integrates and interprets the steps and processes involved in implement Board policies and other appropriate laws used in determining students program and service needs
