Middle Man-beginning of the story

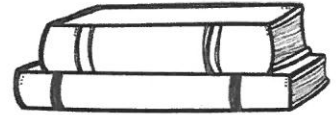
Ring-middle of the story

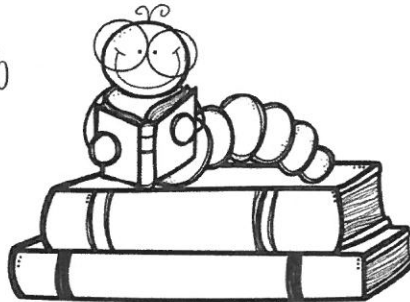
