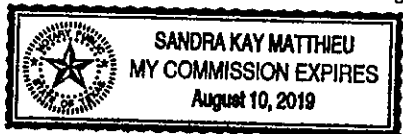

AFFIDAVIT DISCLOSING OF INTEREST IN BUSINESS ENTITY

STATE OF TEXAS

I, King Davis, as a local government officer of the Sheldon Independent School District make this affidavit and hereby on oath state the following:

I have a substantial interest in a business entity as described by the following portion of the Texas Local Government Code § 171.002:

A public official is considered to have a substantial interest in a business entity or real property if the official's relative within the first degree of consanguinity (blood) or affinity (marriage) has a substantial interest in the business entity or real property. *Id.* §171.002(c). As such, any "substantial interest" that a public official's spouse, parent, child, step-child, father or mother-in-law, or son or daughter-in-law has is imputed to the public official. TEX. GOV'T CODE §§ 573.023-.024; Tex. Att'y Gen. Op. No. DM-267 (1993), at 2; Tex. Att'y Gen. LO-95-080, at 3. For example, a public official has a "substantial interest" in a business that employs the official's daughter if the official's daughter earns a small income, which exceeds ten percent of her gross income. *See* Tex. Att'y Gen. Op. No. JC-0063 (1999).
