<p>We, at Kerr-Vance Academy, strive to provide for our students an intensive liberal arts college preparatory program in a safe atmosphere where all are treated respectfully. We endeavor to maintain high expectations while actively engaging our students in learning. Further, we strive to foster intellectual curiosity, concern for others, physical development, creativity, and social and moral values.</p>	<p>The curriculum at KVA is a college-preparatory program. Students generally carry five academic courses and one elective. Twenty-two credits are required for graduation. In addition, graduates are required to complete 60 hours of community service during their four-years of high school. Transfer students' grades from other institutions are not combined with the courses/grades here at the Academy. The student's GPA on the KVA transcript reflects only the classes completed at KVA. A separate copy of the previous school record is included with our transcript. Kerr-Vance students have the option to take courses online if the class is not offered at KVA, or if the class is considered an elective credit. Online classes appear on our transcript and are included in the KVA GPA.</p>
