Uniform	How To Wear It
<p><u>Slacks:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Grades Y5-8 wear navy blue dress slacks with front zipper and belt loops. Must be a Docker-type, dress twill or corduroy style. Plain-front and pleated-front slacks are acceptable. Not permitted: jean-style, flares, slacks with rivets, and slacks with exterior pockets (i.e. cargo pants). Grades 6-8 will wear uniform navy blue dress slacks on mass days. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Must be worn at the waist. Must be worn with a solid navy, black, or brown belt. (Grades 1- 8) Belts with rivets or grommets are not allowed.
<p><u>Shorts:</u> (May 1st through September 30th)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Grades Y5-8 wear navy blue knee-length walking shorts with front zipper and belt loops. Plain-front and pleated-front shorts are acceptable. Shorts are not permitted mass days for students in grades 6-8. Not permitted: cargo shorts. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Must be worn at the waist. Must be worn with a solid navy, black, or brown belt. Belts with rivets or grommets are not allowed.
<p><u>Shirts:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Grades Y5-8 wear a solid white polo-style shirt, a solid white oxford cloth shirt, or a solid white turtleneck shirt. Grades 6-8 also have the option of wearing a solid red polo-style or turtleneck shirt. Grades 6-8 also have the option of wearing a solid red polo-style or turtleneck shirt. A blue HFRS logo is the only acceptable logo, if one is used. Grades 6-8 will wear a white Oxford cloth shirt without a logo on mass days, along with the designated tie. Oxford cloth and Polo-style shirts must button down the front, have a collar and may be long or short sleeved. Turtleneck shirts must have a rolled neck and may be short or long sleeved. The only logo permitted is the HFRS cross logo. Not permitted: mock turtleneck. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Shirt must be tucked into the slacks with the waistband visible. Only the top button of the shirt may be unbuttoned. Solid white, short sleeved t-shirt or undershirt may be worn underneath uniform shirt. Undershirt sleeves should not extend beyond the sleeve of the uniform shirt.
<p><u>Sweaters:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Grades Y5-8 may wear a solid navy, red, or white sweaters. Cardigans, vests, crewneck and v-neck pullover styles are acceptable. Sweaters may have the HFRS cross logo only. Not permitted: hooded, striped, or multi-colored design sweaters. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> An oxford cloth shirt, polo-style shirt, or turtleneck must be worn under the sweater.
<p><u>Sweatshirts:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Grade 8 may wear the class sweatshirt, except at mass. Students in grades Y5-8 may wear a quarter zip fleece, with the HFRS logo. This fleece must have the HFRS logo. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> An oxford cloth shirt, polo-style shirt, or turtleneck must be worn under the sweatshirt. Sweatshirts with the HFRS Logo or Wildcat logo are not to be worn during the school day.

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<p><u>Socks:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Grades Y5-8 wear solid white, navy, or black crew socks. • Crew socks should be 3 inches above the ankle and able to fold over. • Not permitted: Socks displaying a manufacturer’s logo. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Socks must be worn and visible at all times. • Only one pair of socks may be worn at a time. • Crew socks must be worn with tennis shoes.
<p><u>Shoes:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Solid black, brown or navy leather or suede dress shoes that are closed at the toe and heel. • Shoes should tie, velcro, or be loafer style. • Not permitted: sandals, clogs, moccasins or shoes with built-in wheels. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Shoes with laces should be tied. • Tennis shoes may be worn with the navy blue uniform shorts. • On gym days, grades Y5-5 may wear tennis shoes or athletic shoes for the entire day. • On gym days, grades 6-8 should wear their dress shoes to school and change to gym shoes only for Physical Education (PE) class. • Boots are to be worn to and from school or at recess only.
<p><u>Accessories:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A simple cross or religious medal with chain, a wristwatch, or one modest ring is permitted. • WWJD bracelets are the only bracelets allowed. • Ties may be worn on dress-up days only. • Not permitted: earrings 	
<p><u>Hair:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hair must be a natural color as well as neat and clean at all times. • Boys’ haircuts must be above the collar, ears, and eyebrows. • Not permitted: excessive fad haircuts or styles. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hairstyle is not to be a distraction.
<p><u>Gym Uniforms:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Grades 4-8 wear a PE uniform for class. • White t-shirt with logo and blue shorts with logo must be ordered through the school website. • Tennis shoes and socks are required for PE. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • PE uniforms are available at <i>Kids Choice Apparel</i>.
<p><u>Non-Uniform Days:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Appropriate non-uniform dress is to be worn. • Not permitted: Tank tops, flip-flops, sandals, ripped or torn clothing. Clothing with inappropriate ads or promotions for music groups, movies, television shows, etc. that promote actions contrary to HFRS policies. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Parents should carefully scrutinize shirts and pants with mottos, graphics, and ads. • Slacks and shorts must be worn at the waist. • Shorts are permitted May 1st through September 30th. • Socks must be worn
<p><u>Dress Up Days:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Clothes that are appropriate for a “better” occasion. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Designated dress-up days are usually picture day and the last day of school.

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- Appropriate clothes might be: collared Polo-style shirt, dress shirt, tie, nice pants, dress shorts, jacket, and dress shoes.
- **Not permitted:** jeans, cargo shorts, sandals.

- Belts must be worn.
- Dress shorts are permitted May 1st-September 30th.
