Do's



Don'ts

<p>Do WALK to the sidewalks and hand out candy, flyers, etc.</p>	<p>Don't THROW candy, flyers, toys, etc. from the float. <i>This is a safety hazard.</i></p>
<p>Make sure that all drivers are 21 years old or older. Must have a driver's license and a current proof of insurance on his/her person on the day of the parade.</p>	<p>No one under 21 years old may drive in the parade. Instead, enjoy riding on the float.</p>
<p>Be safe, act appropriately, have fun and show the community what being a Roo is all about!</p>	<p>Any participant displaying behavior that is deemed unsafe or inappropriate by WHS/NGC staff and/or law enforcement will be asked to leave all parade activities immediately and will not be allowed to return to the parade.</p>
<p>Have fun thinking of your float design and creating your float. Get creative.</p>	<p>Don't forget to label your float in some way so that we all know we are waving at. (Volleyball, Class of 1964, etc.)</p>
<p>Cheer and wave to the crowd. Let your Roo pride show!</p>	<p>Don't just sit there! Interact with the crowds. They came to see you.</p>
<p>When we get your float application we will send you a "CONSENT AND AGREEMENT FOR PARTICIPATION AND INDEMNIFICATION FORM." Each rider must sign and return this form to the person responsible for the float. Please keep these on you during the parade and be ready to show them when asked.</p>	<p>Don't forget that all minors need to have a consent form signed by a parent. For safety, children 12 years old and under who ride on a float need to be on the float with an adult or a teenager.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">←</p>
<p>When we get your float application, we will send you an Indemnity Form Agreement. The person responsible for the float MUST sign the "Indemnity Form Agreement" and turn it into the parade zone worker in the parking lot during parade line up time on the day of the parade.</p>	<p>Don't leave all your forms at home. Bring them with you.</p>
