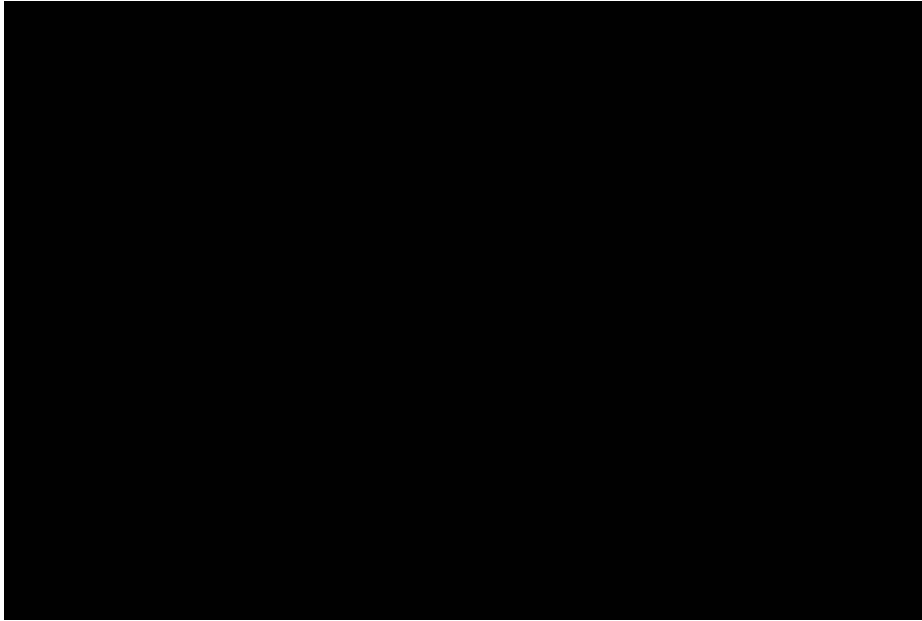


AUTISM AWARENESS DAY AT CITI FIELD 2019
