Our administration was made aware of a threat to our campus that was circulated on social media. The Honolulu Police Department and the Federal Bureau of Investigation were notified immediately and are currently investigating. Out of an abundance of caution, police and additional security will be present on campus.

All threats to our school or students are taken very seriously and are investigated thoroughly. Terroristic threats are considered Class A student conduct offenses. Penalties can range from detention to dismissal with the possibility of arrest and serious criminal charges. If you discover anything that can assist in the investigation, please contact HPD immediately.

According to Honolulu Police, reposting a threat is as good as making the threat itself and contributes to prolonging the event. We encourage parents to speak with their child about making the right choices and the potential consequences of their actions. I urge all students and families to refrain from reposting threats and rumors online.
