**Classroom parties/Field Trips-** Please make sure you are volunteer approved before coming to classroom parties or volunteering for class Field Trips. We don't want to turn parents away at the door however it is our district policy that all parents/adults attending classroom parties, field trips or volunteering must be volunteer approved. We highly encourage parents to arrange childcare for younger siblings when attending classroom parties however we recognize that this isn't always possible. If you bring a younger sibling to a classroom party you are responsible for your child and their safety while in the building.

**SNOW-** As the weather begins to change please make sure your child is wearing appropriate winter clothes and shoes to stay warm outside. Our snow rules for our school are:

- Keep the snow on the ground (including to and from school)
- Walk on the blacktop
- Students may build snowmen and snow buildings
- Be respectful with others snowmen and snow buildings (Please do not ruin others work)
- Stay SAFE- do not slide on the blacktop or stand on snow structures
- Snow stays outside- Stomp your feet, shake your hands off before you enter the building
