Exempted students may be excluded from school or child care settings and activities during an outbreak of the disease that they have not been fully vaccinated against. The diseases vaccines can protect against still exist, and can spread quickly in school and child care settings. Immunizations are one of the best ways to protect people from getting and spreading diseases that may result in serious illness, disability, or death.
