1 The major objective of student health services is to protect and promote the health of the student. This  
2 responsibility is shared by all individuals and agencies in the community.  
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4 To obtain this objective:

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- 6 1. A safe, sanitary, healthful school environment shall be provided; and
- 7
- 8 2. Basic principles of healthful living shall be taught.
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10 The student health services program<sup>1</sup> shall include:

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- 12 1. Identification of physical, mental or emotional characteristics of students which will prevent
- 13 them from attaining their potentialities through public education;
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- 15 2. Evidence of a complete medical examination of every student entering school for the first
- 16 time;
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- 18 3. Proof of immunization except those who are exempt by statute;
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- 20 4. A medical examination as directed by the TSSAA of every student prior to participation in
- 21 interscholastic athletics;
- 22
- 23 5. A cumulative health record;
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- 25 6. A record for each student which contains information as to how and where to contact parents
- 26 in case of emergency. **Parents who change phone numbers and home address must report and**
- 27 **update this information with the school principal within one week;**
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- 29 7. A report of each accident taking place while the student in under the jurisdiction of the
- 30 school;
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- 32 8. Plan for taking care of sick or injured students;
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- 34 9. Procedures for reporting suspected child abuse or neglect;

- 2       10. Plan for dealing with communicable diseases;
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- 4       11. Procedures for dispensing medication;
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- 6       12. Teacher referral of students for available health service; and
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- 8       13. Method for evaluating criteria, including the extent and use of available health services based  
      upon the needs of students within the school.
