La Salle Catholic College Preparatory High School, a 5A member of the Northwest Oregon Conference (NWOC) and Oregon School Activities Association (OSAA) is hiring for the position of **JV Head Coach/Assistant Coach**. The ideal candidate possesses excellent teaching skills and demonstrates passion for leading and motivating student-athletes. Serving as an assistant for the tennis program includes possessing excellent knowledge of the game, successful leadership and management of student-athletes, supporting head coaches in the execution of their vision, and contributing to the successful student-athlete experience to which La Salle, NWOC and the OSAA are committed.

### Essential Duties

- Develop and form student-athletes in the spirit of Lasallian education in collaboration with the parents, administrators, faculty, staff, etc...
- Enthusiastically motivate and develop talented and well-rounded student-athletes
- Develop, promote and execute a successful tennis program including the coordination of highly effective practices, youth camps and summer baseball season
- Articulate, set and hold student-athletes to high expectations
- Implement along with the head coach an off-season workout program for athletes
- Execute practice schedules in collaboration with head coaches
- Maintain necessary certifications
- Assist the head coach and student-athletes in executing the game strategy and adapting when necessary
- Partner with school personnel in the to properly support the needs of the tennis program with respect to communication, fundraising and other operational needs
- Assist with maintaining and updating inventory of equipment, supplies, uniforms,

practice gear, apparel, and additional items

- Effectively communicate with players and parents using school approved forms of electronic communication and maintain an online presence to help inform and promote the program to the community
- Manage playing time as it relates to each level (V/JV) of play and stress the importance of sportsmanship with student-athletes
- Assist in the design and execution of safe practice sessions on a daily basis and communicate effectively with students, coaches, parents and the trainer in the event of an injury or illness
- Assist the head coach in using registration software to properly account for eligible student-athletes cleared for participation
- Assist in setting up, managing and cleaning-up equipment for all athletic contests and practices

### Skills and Abilities

- Ability to cooperate as a team member with other school colleagues and administration in an effort to meet key initiatives
- Strong organizational skills necessary to meet deadlines and to satisfy the requirements of the position
- Detail oriented and ability to work under time sensitive deadlines; ability to multi-task, prioritize and follow through on a variety of concurrent projects
- Ability to communicate concisely and effectively, both verbally and in writing
