



2020 Spring Testing Schedule Beaver Creek High School



The ACT will be administered to all juniors, free of charge, during the school day on February 25, 2020. Students that earn a remediation free score are waived from the graduation point requirement of the Ohio State Tests. Remediation free scores are: English=18, Reading=22, Math=22. Students that achieve these scores are waived from the 18 point Ohio State Test requirement, but still must take each test.

Beaver Creek High School will utilize a block schedule in order to administer the Ohio State Tests (OST) in April. Tests will be administered April 7th —April 17th during the school day. Make-up tests will be administered during the week of April 20th. Students will be pulled from their assigned class in order to make up any test they may have missed.

Example Student Testing Schedule

Below is a sample student schedule for the first two days of testing to demonstrate how this altered schedule will work for students. The testing blocks are highlighted in yellow.

Sample Student Schedule

1st Period Spanish II
2nd Period English Language Arts 10 (TESTED COURSE)
3rd Period Art
4th Period American History (TESTED COURSE)
5th Period Geometry (TESTED COURSE)
6th Period P.E.
7th Period Biology (TESTED COURSE)

***This student is a sophomore and has 4 courses that require an OST, which is typical for most sophomores. Some students, however, may have taken Geometry and/or Biology as a freshmen and taken the test the previous school year.**

April 7th Start the day in 1st Period—schedule for the day is reviewed with students daily
1st Class Block---3rd Period---Regular class for shortened period
2nd Class Block---1st Period—Spanish is NOT a tested course—Regular class
3rd Class Block—2nd Period---Tested class but not a testing block—Regular class
4th Class Block---Lunch with Advisory Class
5th Class Block---4th Period—Tested class—Take Part 1 of History Ohio State Test
6th Class Block—5th Period—Tested class but not a testing block—Regular class

April 8th Start the day in 1st Period—schedule for the day is reviewed with students daily
1st Class Block—2nd Period—Tested class but not a testing block—Regular class
2nd Class Block---2nd Period--Tested class---Take Part 1 of ELA Ohio State Test
3rd Class Block---3rd Period-- Regular Class for shortened period
4th Class Block---Lunch with Advisory Class
5th Class Block---5th Period—Tested Class—Take Part 1 of Geometry Ohio State Test
6th Period---6th Period--Regular Class for shortened period

The sample student above has tested courses during 2nd, 4th, 5th, and 7th periods. On both of the example days above, the student will test twice, but on other dates he/she would only have one test or no tests at all. This allows students some easier days and some rest days, depending upon their schedule. Additionally, students do not have school on Friday, April 10th and Monday, April 13th; thus students will have a break from testing at that time.
