

Stone Canyon Elementary - Frequently Asked Questions

Student Drop Off:

When dropping students off in the morning, please make sure there is a staff member at the back door to greet them. If there is not a staff member present, please bring your child to the front office on the south side of the building.

Deliveries to Students:

There will always be times when your child has forgotten something at home and you will want to deliver it to the school. Our office staff is happy to assist in connecting your child with an item. Simply leave it in the office with their name on it.

Specialty Items:

Delivery of specialty items are not permitted. Things like balloons, cupcakes, flowers and stuffed animals may not be delivered to your child's classroom. If anything is delivered, students are only allowed to pick it up at the end of the day. Please remember that balloons and glass vases should not be transported by a student riding a bus.

Student Birthdays:

Student Birthdays are recognized within your child's classroom, but birthday parties are not permitted. This includes bringing cakes, cupcakes, snacks, candy, invitations for parties or gifts for a celebration.

Student Meals:

Parents are welcome to eat lunch with their children. Please remember you must scan your driver's license and receive clearance from our office to join us. Due to the variety of student allergies and respect for the wishes of other parents, parents are allowed to bring food for their child only.

Inclement Weather Pick-ups:

We respect that at times during inclement weather you may choose to pick your child up early. However, we do ask that when picking up please be aware that when entering our office we may have young or worried ears nearby. Nothing concerns a student more than hearing fear or panic in the voice of an adult. We work diligently in our office to always remain weather aware, but also maintain a sense of calm and comfort for our students. Please be patient with us as this could be a busy time. We appreciate your support of our efforts in advance.

Animals at Arrival & Dismissal:

While it is tempting to bring up beloved pets to see your child off for their day or to greet your child after school, please refrain from bringing your family pets to school. Arrival and dismissal of a school can be busy and overwhelming for animals. For the safety of our students, families, staff, and pets, please keep them at home. We thank you for your cooperation with this matter.

Playground Etiquette for Parents/Guardians:

While it can be tempting to want to stop and watch your child play out at recess, parents and stopped vehicles are not permitted outside of our playground areas. We practice a safe space for our students and if you linger near our fence you will be viewed as a stranger and could cause unnecessary alarm as our teachers and staff notify the administrators and School Resource Officers should someone linger nearby. Please help us stay free from distraction and our students free from concern.
