3. Love/Belonging = Friendship, Family, & Sexual Intimacy.
4. Safety = Security of Body, Employment, Resources, Morality, The Family, Health, & of Property.
5. Physiological = Breathing, Food, Water, Sex, Sleep, Homeostasis, & Excretion.
