# Online Registration Now Available at Brookings-Harbor School District

## FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE

[Brookings, Ore.] – Brookings-Harbor School District invites the families of new and returning students to complete mandatory registration and enrollment activities on Aug. 16 or 17.

Registration activities will be available from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Wednesday, Aug. 16; and from noon to 6 p.m. Thursday, Aug. 17 at Brookings-Harbor High School. All grades — including elementary and middle school should meet in the high school auditorium to begin the process.

New this year, online registration will be available to families in advance, and help will be on hand for anyone who has not yet completed the school district's new online forms.

The online process, through PowerSchool, will replace paper forms sent home with students in the past. The online process will also allow the district to verify each student's demographic, emergency and medical information prior to the start of the new school year, and for parents to electronically sign the annual permission forms for school district policies.

The online form will be available after Aug. 9, giving families the option of completing it in advance. Parents and guardians of current students will receive a letter or email from BHSD with instructions on how to access the system. Parents of new students to the district will need to come to in-person registration on Aug. 16 or 17 or meet with their school's registrar. After each student has taken care of registration, they can receive their teacher and room assignment, or locker and class schedule. Staff and volunteers will also be on hand Aug. 16 and 17 to answer questions about the school nurse and health options, bus routes, English Language Development program, food service, Alternative and Special Education, the Parent-Teacher Organization, the Booster Club, and more. Parents will also be able to pay for sports fees, purchase PE uniforms and other school related activities. Help will be available for all registration activities during these two registration days.
