Both programs are selective and require an application and a test for admission. Applications are now available for current 5<sup>th</sup> graders (seeking admission for the 6<sup>th</sup> grade) and current 6<sup>th</sup> graders (limited spaces for the 7<sup>th</sup> grade)

AEP is a fast-paced, innovative, interdisciplinary, middle school program that provides intensive enrichment and acceleration leading to high school level coursework while still in middle school.
