

Be Informed: Use Proper Online Behavior



Say:

How many of you use the internet on one of these devices?

Allow students time to answer and respond

Say:

When you are on the internet, you should use appropriate online behavior.

Say :

What is appropriate online behavior and being a good digital citizen?

Allow students to discuss and answer.

Say:

- Be careful what you say about others
- Be truthful
- Use appropriate language
- Don't joke about illegal things
- Avoid making fun of others
- Here are some **inappropriate behaviors** that are against our **District Policy**:
- Accessing inappropriate websites (obscene)
- Posting threatening or rude comment (bullying)
- Accessing sites without permission (hacking)

Say:

How many of you have an account on Facebook, SnapChat, Skype, Oovoo, YouTube, Kik, Twitter, or Instagram?
 Allow students to respond to the question

Say:

Use the privacy settings on your accounts.
 Remember that what you post can be SAVED, RE-POSTED or COPIED by any person with access.
 Remember that nothing is “private” online.

Say:

“What types of things can you share on a social network?”
 ***Allow students to respond to question ***

Say:

A social network or electronic communication allows you to share.

- Pictures
- Videos
- Favorite website links

Say:

What can your online friends do with the items that you share on a social network, email or on an instant message?
 Allow students to discuss and respond

Say:

“Your online friends can

- Comment
- repost (with or without permission)
- copy anything you share.

Because of this – it is important to limit your online friends to people that you trust.”

“Remember to always manage your personal settings responsibly”

Be Aware: Online personal safety

- DON' T give out your age or birth date
- DON' T give out your address, or your complete name
- DON' T give out your social security numbers, passwords
- DON' T give out your school or afterschool schedule



Say:

What is personal information?

****Allow students to respond.****

Say:

Some examples of personal information are your:

- birthdate
- full first and last name
- age
- address
- social security number
- passwords
- school schedule
- afterschool activities

Say:

You should never give out personal information to advertisements, in a chat room, in an email, or on a social network site.

Be Responsible: Think before you act



Say:

Consider these questions when communicating online. Only send or post a message online to someone if you can answer YES to at least one of the following questions:

1. Is it true?
2. Is it helpful?
3. Is it inspiring?
4. Is it necessary?
5. Is it kind?

Be Responsible: Don't Text and Drive



Say:

- Ignore texts from people they don't know
- If someone else posts hurtful or inappropriate messages -- do not respond, but do tell a teacher, parent or other adult
- Do not text while driving
- Do not post hurtful or inappropriate messages.
- Do save messages that upset you and show them to your parents.

Be Responsible: Report Cyber Bullying

Cyber Bullying is bullying using technology such as:

- phones
- laptops
- ipads
- ipods
- gaming devices

Say:

What are some examples of cyber bullying?

allow students to respond

Say:

Some examples of cyber bullying are:

- Spreading rumors and gossip
- Posting pictures & videos of someone without permission
- Hacking someone’s account
- Threatening someone
- Harassing someone
- Using offensive language

Say

If you or someone you know is being cyber bullied you should:

- Not respond
- Tell a trusted adult (parent, teacher, counselor, Principal)
- Remember that any type of bullying is against school district policy.
