- May 3 College t-shirt day for seniors

- May 6-17 Advanced Placement exams
- May 10 Last day for seniors. Lockers need to be cleaned out. There will be a \$25 fine for lockers that are left with books, trash and/or other materials. Book return will be open at 3:10 P.M. in the cafeteria.
- May 11 Prom 8:00 P.M. to 11:00 P.M. Students must arrive by 9:00 P.M. and remain until the end of the dance. This is a formal dance. Students should be in evening attire. Neatness, modesty and moderation should be considered in your choice of attire.
- May 13-14 Senior Exams (for non-AP classes). Those seniors who have earned a grade of 85 or above (unweighted) and have less than ten absences in a course are exempt from taking the final in that class. These are dress down days. Seniors can return textbooks and donate used uniforms from 1-3 P.M. in the cafeteria on these days.
- May 15 Academic Awards Banquet at the Embassy Suites, by invitation only. Invitations will be mailed the first week of May - attire is "church clothes" and will be specified in the invitation letter.
- May 16 MANDATORY -All students must remain from 8:30 A.M. - 3:00P.M. Last school Prayer Service and Awards Ceremony followed by senior lunch (\$5 can be brought in to Mrs. Bruggeman) and graduation practice. Seniors arrive at LCHS at 8:30 A.M. Men wear shirt, tie, dress pants and dress shoes. Women wear dresses, skirts and blouses, or blouses and dress pants (shoulders covered, hems to the knee), and dress shoes. It is suggested that shoes for ladies be of the same height as those to be worn to graduation so that they can practice walking across the stage.
