

How to Calculate Your Marking Period GPA:

Your number grade corresponds to a letter grade, which also equals a value of 0.0 to 4.3

Grade %	Letter	Grade Value
68-69	D	1.4
70-72	C-	1.7
73-76	C	2.0
77-79	C+	2.4
80-82	B-	2.7
83-86	B	3.0
87-89	B+	3.3
90-92	A-	3.7
93-96	A	4.0
97-100	A+	4.3

- Add up the value of each grade for each of your classes (Math, Language Arts, Science, Social Studies, Phys. Ed, & your current elective - Art, STEM, or World Language) and divide by 10, because each course carries a credit value of 1.25 per marking period. Math and Language Arts count TWICE since you have them double periods.
- For example: If John has a 87 in Math, a 92 in Language Arts, a 84 in Science, a 95 in Social Studies, a 75 in Phys. Ed, and a 80 in Art, you would add:

$$3.3 + 3.3 + 3.7 + 3.7 + 3.0 + 4.0 + 2.0 + 2.7 = 25.7$$

$$25.7 \times 1.25 = 32.125$$

$$32.125 \div 10 = 3.21$$

Therefore, 3.2 is John's Marking Period GPA.

- For Honor Roll, you must have a 3.0 or higher and no grade lower than a B-. For High Honor Roll, you must have a 3.5 or higher and no grade lower than a B+.
