**Sexual Harassment**

The Board is committed to the elimination of sexual harassment in district schools and activities. Sexual harassment is strictly prohibited and shall not be tolerated. This includes sexual harassment of students, staff or third parties by other students staff, Board members or third parties.

Principals and the superintendent have the responsibility for the investigations concerning sexual harassment. All complaints about behavior that may violate this policy shall be promptly investigated. Any employee who has knowledge of conduct in violation of this policy or feels he/she is a victim of sexual harassment must immediately report his/her concerns to the principal, Title IX coordinator or superintendent, who has overall responsibility for all investigations. Any student may also report concerns to a teacher, counselor or school nurse, who will promptly notify the appropriate principal, Title IX Coordinator or superintendent.

The superintendent is directed to develop administrative regulations to implement this policy. Regulations shall include descriptions of prohibited conduct, reporting, and investigative procedures, and provisions to ensure annual notice of this policy is provided to students, staff and third parties.
