Howdy Wolfpack!

My name is Justin Grimes and I am the new College View High School Principal. Let me be the first to welcome each of you to the 2018-2019 school year! I believe in providing clear, and consistent communication so that you can feel connected to our campus while staying informed and prepared. I get asked all the time, "What do Principals do in the Summer?". My answer is simple: We work on all the details to prepare for the upcoming school year. I am big on the details and doing the little things well because they impact the big things. Here are several details to be aware of as we get closer to the 1st day of school on Monday, August 20:

1. Wolfpack Orientation is scheduled for Monday, August 6. There will be 2 sessions to choose from (AM Session from 9:00-11:00 or PM Session from 2:00 - 4:00). Students MUST attend at least one of these sessions. Parents are welcome to join. If you cannot make this date, the make-up orientation will be Friday, August 17 from 2:00 - 4:00 PM.
  - a. This will be a time for us to connect to you and your family while we share important details about our campus. You will receive your Wolfpack Guide, a spirit t-shirt, take your picture for your student ID (which will cost \$8 for the year), obtain parking pass for \$25 (please register at [www.cvhs.csisd.org](http://www.cvhs.csisd.org)), sign up for clubs, and obtain a copy of your schedule. We will also have our CVHS school "store" open with swag items such as hoodies, baseball T's, beanies, sunglasses, headphones, windbreakers, and duffel bags available for purchase or to order.
  - b. We will also confirm that you are InfoSnap registered (if not already). If you do not have internet access, please plan to stay after the Orientation session and register online from school. If you have changed your address over the summer, you need to bring proof of your current residency. Documentation for residency could include a lease agreement or utility bill with your name or your parent/guardian's name on it. Parent/Guardian must attend this meeting with you if you are under 18 years of age, and it is strongly encouraged for parents/guardians of adult students to attend as well.
2. Dual Credit (DC) Orientation is scheduled for Monday, August 6 from 1:00 - 1:30 PM. All students who are taking DC courses must attend. Parents are welcome to join. If you cannot make this date, the make-up orientation will be Friday, August 17 at 2:00 PM.
3. CVHS Open House is scheduled for Thursday, September 20 at 6:00 PM.

  - a. On July 17, 2018 the CSISD school board approved Policy FNF (LOCAL), which enacts a student drug testing policy. The policy will take effect October 1, 2018, to plan for and ensure consistent implementation across campuses and programs. Students in grades 9-12 who participate in extracurricular activities, as well as those who wish to purchase a parking pass for their respective campus, will be subject to random drug testing. In addition, parents can voluntarily opt their student into the drug testing program if they do not meet one of the aforementioned criteria. Local orientation and consent process planning is currently underway and more information will be made available soon at [csisd.org](http://csisd.org).
