Smiles for a Lifetime Center Now Open in Hampton School District One

Hampton One students without a dental home can now receive dental services within the school district this year. With a generous grant from the Charlotte, N.C.-based **Duke Endowment**, the nonprofit health care network **Welvista** has established a **Smiles for a Lifetime Dental Center**. The center is housed on the campus of **Varnville Elementary School**. Students from all Hampton One schools now have the opportunity to receive cleaning, sealants, and / or restorative treatments. In addition to services provided by the new **Smiles for a Lifetime Center**, Hampton One will continue to work with and coordinate dental and health services with **Beaufort Jasper Hampton Comprehensive Health Services** for a number of Hampton One schools. Critical dental care needed beyond cleaning and restorative procedures will be referred to a local dental provider.

The primary purpose of the new dental center is to provide support to Hampton One children who do not have a dental home or can not afford dental care. A parent or guardian must sign a consent form before a student will be able to receive services.

The district is seeking a used car or van so that transportation can be provided from the schools to the dental clinic. If anyone is interested in making a donation of a reliable vehicle for this purpose, an appropriate tax deductible letter can be provided to the donor.
