



**Nampa School District No. 131
Wireless Access Point Hardware & Installation RFP
Addendum #1—Questions & Clarifications**

As provided for in Section 2 of the General Proposal Conditions & Requirements for the Wireless Access Point Hardware & Installation Request for Proposal due to the District on February 8, 2018, the following specification updates and clarifications will supersede prior specifications or provide additional information as stated below.

Q: Would it be possible to obtain building maps featuring current AP locations so that a design could be made for an alternative product?

Re: Hardware/software support

Q: How many years of support is the District looking for on hardware/software?

A: We are currently running on a year-to-year support contract on the current Xirrus hardware. We would be interested in reviewing options for 1-, 3-, and 5-year support. Please include specific information as to what, if any, baseline support period would be included as standard with the proposed solution. Bidders may also list separately alternative/additional support offers; such offers will be considered as optional add-ons, with the District holding the option to exercise as an addition to the winning proposal.

Re: Missed walkthrough

1/26/2018

Q: Our company mistakenly missed the walkthrough scheduled for January 25. Are we still able to bid the project? Can we schedule a second walkthrough?

A: A building walkthrough is required as part of the proposal process, and no proposal will be accepted without a company representative having attended such a walkthrough. In the interest of competition, we will accommodate the request for a second walkthrough on **Friday, February 2, 2018 at 1:00 pm**. We cannot allow, however, any sort of private walkthrough or meeting, with only a single potential bidder. Thus, this second walkthrough will be open to all interested bidders, including those who attended the initial walkthrough on January 25. Those who attended the original walkthrough are not required to attend this second meeting, but may do so at their choosing. As before, this meeting will start at the Technology office at 1002 Front Street, Nampa, and attendees will be responsible for their own transportation.

Re: Quantity of WAPs

2/12/2018

Q: The original 470 posting indicates an expected (approximate) quantity of 150 WAPs. Based on the walkthrough, we estimate that the actual quantity required will be more than this amount. Should the proposal reflect the quantity listed on the 470 posting?

A: The 470 posting indicates the actual WAP quantity was “to be determined at the mandatory walkthrough.” The total quantity of WAPs should be that required to fully and properly implement the proposed solution.
