

PURCHASE LINE SCHOOL DISTRICT FAMILY MEDICAL LEAVE ACT (FMLA)

The Family and Medical Leave Act (FMLA) allows employees who qualify up to 12 work weeks of unpaid leave a year for the birth, adoption, foster placement of a child, or for the care of family members or the employees themselves in the event of a serious illness. During this time, group health benefits are maintained as though the employee was working and a position is held for the employee.
