## **EL DORADO HIGH SCHOOL**

### **SENIOR RESPONSIBILITIES CLASS OF 2018**

In accordance with the District's rules and regulations on student behavior, and in an effort to make graduation and the activities preceding it a more meaningful experience, each member of the *Class of 2018* needs to be aware of the following requirements. Failure to comply with these requirements may result in exclusion from senior activities, exclusion from the graduation ceremony and/or the withholding of diplomas and records.

#### **GENERAL:**

- 1. Seniors are students of El Dorado High School until they complete all graduation activities. All discipline policies, rules and regulations apply.**
- 2. In order to participate in the graduation ceremony and receive a diploma, seniors must meet all of the academic requirements set forth by the Board of Education. These requirements are detailed in the student handbook which is available at edhs.org.**
- 3. Any member of the senior class who participates in activities disruptive to school operations, destructive to school property and/or causes the school to expend monies for clean up and repair shall be excluded from senior activities – including the graduation ceremony. Diplomas and all permanent records shall be held, as necessary, until restitution is made.**

#### **LIBRARY, TEXTBOOK and EQUIPMENT DEBTS:**

**All library books, textbooks and equipment must be returned, or payment must be made for all missing items prior to cap and gown distribution. It is the responsibility of each senior to clear any charges. Seniors who have debts will have their caps and gowns, diplomas and transcripts held until the debts are cleared. All debts must be paid in CASH or by CASHIER'S CHECK TO THE FINANCE OFFICE.**

#### **SATURDAY SCHOOL HOURS:**

**All seniors owing Saturday School hours must serve hours by Saturday, June 9, 2018. Failure to serve hours will result in loss of senior privileges including senior week activities and graduation.**

#### **GRADUATION:**

- 1. ATTENDANCE AT ALL SENIOR MEETINGS AND PRACTICE IS REQUIRED. YOU MUST ATTEND THE GRADUATION PRACTICE IN ORDER TO PARTICIPATE IN THE CEREMONY.**
- 2. Any student who uses, is in possession of, or under the influence of, alcohol or a controlled substance (drugs) or is in possession of any related paraphernalia during the graduation exercises, or any school sponsored activity that precedes graduation, will not be allowed to participate in the graduation ceremony.**
- 3. The graduation ceremony is a serious exercise. Students are not to bring to the ceremony any items which may cause a disruption or detract from the dignity of the event. Proper behavior is expected throughout the ceremony. Graduates who do not display proper behavior will be removed.**
