- 2017-18 School Land Trust Plan – had a carryover of \$3328.49
- Principal Hamm reviewed the 2018-19 School Land Trust Plan
  - ASL and Spanish got their textbooks
  - Technology for Auditorium
- Principal Hamm explained how ACT Day (October 2<sup>nd</sup>) was going to work on the school level
- Melinda Dow was introduced as the new reading specialist
  - She reported that all was going well and even ahead of where she thought it would be

- Hopes to keep numbers down – no more than 4-6 students per class period
  - The response has been overwhelming positive
- Principal Hamm explained the difference between the SAGE and ACT
  - SAGE scores were up in most subject areas. The biggest drop was in Chemistry (-25%)
