- PURPOSE** To implement a youth scholarship for any students attending a full-time college, university, or technical school. Scholarship funds are to be used directly for tuition, fees, lab fees, and books.
- SCHOLARSHIP** The amount is determined by the number of acceptable qualifying applications. No handwritten forms will be accepted. Applications can be obtained at www.ashtabulafb.org, by email at ashtabula@ofbf.org, or by calling 440.426.2195.
- DUE DATE** **April 15th.** All applications must be received or postmarked by this date.
- JUDGING** A committee shall be chosen by the Ashtabula County Farm Bureau board of trustees. The decision of the judges shall be final. Decisions will be based on a scoring system with a higher emphasis on applicants with agricultural involvement, Farm Bureau involvement, and membership history.
- AWARD** The recipients will be acknowledged at the annual meeting in September. The award will be given after the next term of study is completed and grades have been submitted to the Farm Bureau office. The membership of the applicant/applicants parent/guardians **MUST** be in good standing at the time of application and payout of scholarship monies. Applicants can only be awarded the scholarship twice.
- ELIGIBILITY**
- A resident of Ashtabula County
 - Applicant or applicant's parents/guardians must be paid Ashtabula County Farm Bureau members both at the time of application and at time of payout.
 - The student must be a full-time enrollee in a two or four-year college, university, or technical school, working toward an undergraduate degree.
 - Applicant must show a 3.0 grade point average
 - **A major in agriculture or a support field is preferred but not required.**

APPLICATION PROCESS

1. Fill out the attached application form and complete the essay. No handwritten forms will be accepted.
2. If you are a first year student, attach proof of enrollment or letter of admission.
3. Attach a copy of your high school and/or college transcript of grades.
4. Attach two signed and dated, **current** letters of recommendation, with contact information and phone numbers. One reference must be a current Farm Bureau member.
5. Please include a recent picture to be used for our scholar's page in our annual meeting program.
6. Send completed application, essay, letters of recommendation, proof of enrollment, transcript, and pictures:
