Uniform	How To Wear It
<p><u>Jumpers & Skirts:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Grades Y5-3 wear the HFRS plaid uniform jumper. • Grades 4-8 wear the HFRS plaid uniform skirt. <p style="text-align: center;">Acceptable</p> <div style="display: flex; justify-content: space-around;">  </div>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Jumper length and skirt length is to be no shorter than 2 inches above the top of the kneecap. • Skirts cannot be rolled and must be worn at the waist. • The waistband must be visible. • Slacks under the jumper or skirt may be worn to and from school or at recess only. <p style="text-align: center;">Not acceptable</p> <div style="text-align: center;">  </div>
<p><u>Slacks:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Grades Y5-8 wear navy blue dress slacks or plaid uniform slacks with front zipper and belt loops. • Must be a Dockers, dress twill or corduroy style. • Plain-front and pleated-front slacks are acceptable. • Not permitted: low rise or dropped-hip slacks, capri-style, jean-style, flares, slacks with rivets, and slacks with exterior pockets (i.e. cargo pants). 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must be worn at the waist. • Must be worn with a solid navy, black, or brown belt. • Belts with rivets or grommets are not allowed.
<p><u>Shorts/Skorts:</u> May 1st through September 30th</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Grades Y5-8 wear navy blue knee-length walking shorts with front zipper and belt loops. • Plain-front and pleated-front shorts are acceptable. • Grades Y5-3 have the option of wearing the navy blue skort available at Dennis Uniforms or Kids Choice Apparel. • Not permitted: cargo shorts and uniform plaid shorts. • Grades 6-8 will wear uniform skirts or uniform slacks on all mass days. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Shorts and skorts may be no shorter than 2 inches above the knee. • Must be worn at the waist. • Must be worn with a solid navy, black, or brown belt. • Belts with rivets or grommets are not allowed. <p style="text-align: center;">Not acceptable</p> <div style="text-align: center;">  </div>
<p><u>Blouses/Shirts:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Grades Y5-8 wear a solid white blouse, white polo-style shirt, or a solid white turtleneck shirt. • Grades 6-8 also have the option of wearing a solid red polo-style or turtleneck shirt. A blue HFRS logo is the only acceptable logo, if one is used. 	

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<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Grades 6-8 will wear a white Oxford cloth blouse without a logo on mass days. The Oxford blouse must have a button-down collar.  <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Blouses and polo-style shirts must button down the front, have a plain collar and may be long or short sleeved. Peter Pan collar and oxford style blouses are acceptable. Turtleneck shirts must have a rolled neck and may be short or long sleeved. The only logo permitted is the HFRS cross logo. <p>Not permitted: mock turtleneck, shirts with ornamentation.</p>	
<p><u>Sweaters:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Grades Y5-8 may wear a solid navy, red, or white sweaters. Plain cardigans, vests, crewneck and v-neck pullover styles are acceptable. Sweaters may have the HFRS cross logo only. Not permitted: ruffled, hooded, striped, floral, and multi-colored design sweaters. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Shirt must be tucked into the slacks with the waistband visible. Only the top button of the shirt may be unbuttoned. Solid white, short sleeved t-shirt or undershirt may be worn underneath uniform shirt. Undershirt sleeves should not extend beyond the sleeve of the uniform shirt.
<p><u>Sweatshirts:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Grade 8 may wear the class sweatshirt, except at mass. Students in grades Y5-8 may wear a quarter zip fleece, with the HFRS logo. This fleece must have the HFRS logo 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> A blouse, polo-style shirt, or turtleneck must be worn under the sweater.
<p><u>Socks/Tights:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Grades Y5-8 wear solid white or navy crew socks, knee socks, or tights. Black tights are also permitted. Socks or tights may have a solid cable pattern. Crew socks should be 3 inches above the ankle. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> A blouse, polo-style shirt, or turtleneck must be worn under the sweatshirt. Sweatshirts with the HFRS logo or Wildcat logo are not to be worn during the school day.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Grades Y5-3 may wear white crew socks with uniform plaid trim. Not permitted: Socks or tights displaying a manufacturer's logo. Lacy or frilled socks or tights. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Socks must be worn and visible at all times. Only one pair of socks may be worn at a time. Crew socks must be worn with tennis shoes.
<p><u>Shoes:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Solid black, brown or navy leather or suede dress shoes that are closed at the toe and heel. 	

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<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Shoes should tie, buckle, velcro, or be loafer style. Grades 6-8 may wear ballet flats. <p>Not permitted: Shoes with sequins, sparkles, or accent colors or prints, shoes with heels over one inch, platforms, sandals, clogs, moccasins, ballet flats for grades Y5-5, or shoes with built-in wheels.</p>	
<p><u>Accessories:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A simple cross or religious medal with chain, a wristwatch, or one modest ring is permitted. WWJD bracelets are the only bracelets allowed. One pair of small earrings (such as studs) may be worn. Headbands, bows, scrunchies, and barrettes must be solid red, white, navy, brown, black, gray, or uniform plaid with no logo or embellishments. Bows should not be a distraction; Jo Jo type bows are not part of the uniform. Bows should be 6 inches or smaller. HFRS plaid clutch may be carried (South Campus) Not permitted: multiple or dangling/hoop earrings. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Shoes with laces should be tied. Tennis shoes may be worn with the navy blue uniform shorts. On gym days, grades Y5-5 may wear tennis shoes or athletic shoes for the entire day. On gym days, grades 6-8 should wear their dress shoes to school and change to gym shoes only for physical education (PE) class. Boots are to be worn to and from school or at recess only.
<p><u>Hair and Make-Up:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Hair must be a natural color as well as neat and clean at all times. Grade 8 may wear light natural looking make-up including natural lip-gloss, light blush, lightly applied mascara, and clear nail polish. Not permitted: Make-up or nail polish in grades Y5-7, glitter, unnatural, or heavy make-up, excessive fad haircuts or styles. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Earrings must be worn on earlobe. All accessories should be free of ornamentation.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Hairstyle and make-up are not to be a distraction.

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<p><u>Physical Education (PE) Uniforms:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Grades 4-8 wear a PE uniform for class. • White t-shirt with logo and blue shorts with logo are available at <i>Kids Choice Apparel</i>. • Tennis shoes and socks are required for PE. 	
<p><u>Non-Uniform Days:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Appropriate non-uniform dress is to be worn. • Not permitted: Flip-flops, sandals, tank tops and short tops with the midriff showing, cold shoulder tops, low-rise or dropped-hip slacks, yoga pants, legging, in grades 6-8, logos on seat of pants, ripped or torn clothing, dangling/hoop earrings, tight or revealing attire. Clothing with inappropriate ads or promotions for music groups, movies, television shows, etc. that promote actions contrary to HFRS policies. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Parents should carefully scrutinize shirts and pants with mottos, graphics, and ads. • Slacks and shorts must be worn at the waist. • Shorts and skorts must be no shorter than 2 inches above the knee. • Shorts, capris and skorts are permitted May 1st through September 30th. • Socks must be worn.

<p><u>Dress Up Days:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Clothes that are appropriate for a “better” occasion. • Appropriate clothes might be: dresses, skirts, nice slacks, and dress shoes. • Not permitted: jeans, tennis shoes, flip-flops, shorts, skorts, rompers, tight or revealing attire. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Designated dress-up days are usually picture day and the last day of school. • Dress sandals are permitted May 1st through September 30th.
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
