The ROP Distinguished Student Award program is our opportunity to recognize students who have displayed a positive attitude, demonstrated outstanding skills in class, possess realistic career goals and whose future has been significantly impacted by ROP.

As a Distinguished Student Nominee, you will need to work with your teacher to:

1. Create a **3 to 5-minute** DVD demonstrating why your teacher has nominated you for such an honor. Your DVD should:

- Include your name, ROP class, teacher name and industry.
- Demonstrate the skills learned in your ROP class (e.g., projects, portfolios, or worksites).
- Demonstrate delivery of your presentation using proper voice, eye contact and confidence.
- Include your future career/education plans and how ROP has affected those plans to meet your career/education expectations.
- Tell us why you would recommend ROP to your friends and family.

2. Write a **one-page** summary on how the ROP has impacted your life.

Your DVD will not be scored based on format, or how it looks, but instead on what you tell us. Be real and be proud. **This is all about you!**
