Scarlet Fever

Date: _____

Symptoms: Sore throat due to strep infection. Fever, nausea, vomiting, a fine sand paper red rash turns white with pressure. Skin may peel beginning of second week.

**Incubation
Period:** 1—7 days. Average 2—4 days

**How
Transmitted:** Person-to-person contact or indirectly by contact with articles soiled by secretions from nose and throat.

**Treatment
and
Precautions:** Consult your doctor, bed rest and encourage fluids.

**Return to
School:** After medical treatment and advice of your doctor. Usually not contagious after 24 hours on medication.

**Please call your child's school if your child will be absent
due to above symptoms (or any other illness)**
