This is the time of year when students can get close to using the ten days they have for the year. Please keep track of how

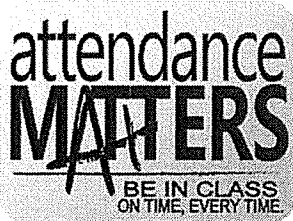
many days they have used and send in any doctors' notes that you have. You can even have the doctor's office fax the note to us at 988-5550.

Remember to check your

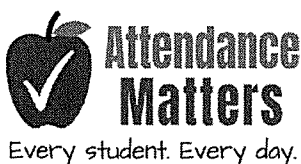
child's planner for any information. Check out those class Friday notes for weekly items that you need to know about.

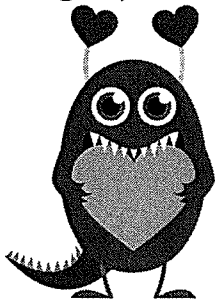
PTO Parent Connection

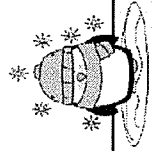


February 14th Teacher Appreciation Mexican Fiesta!



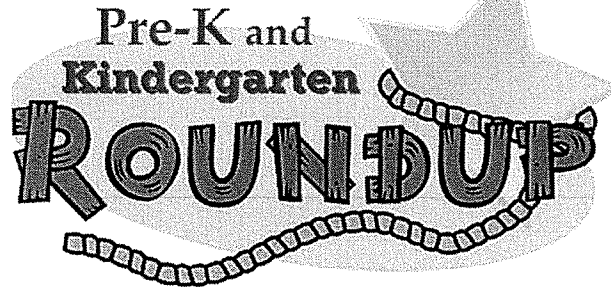

- For more information check Eaton's website (www.eatonschool.org). Click on the link at the tab at the top labeled parents and select "New Student Information".
- For Pre-K, the child must be four years of age on or before August 15, 2020.
- For Kindergarten, the child must be five years of age on or before August 15, 2020.
- The student's legal guardian/parent must complete the forms for registration at the school they wish to attend.
- **For the Pre-K registration, parents will need to provide proof of income.** Income verification documents include pay stubs, W-2 forms, Income Tax 2019, unemployment compensation, worker' compensation documentation, pension stubs, retirement documentation, social security, veteran's benefits letter, child support, alimony documentation, SSI documentation, TANF documentation, foster care reimbursement, Public Assistance payment, TN Care verification. The Voluntary Pre-K program is specifically funded for children in economically disadvantaged situations. However, we encourage everyone to apply even if they may not qualify as economically disadvantaged because occasionally there are student openings after the economically disadvantaged children are placed in the classes.
- **Kindergarten registration will take place at each individual Loudon County Schools based on family address and school zoning.**
- **All Pre-K registration will take place at Loudon County Technology Center on April 17th, 2020 from 8:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m.**
- **For Pre-K and K registration, parents will need to bring: (helpful hint - If you bring us copies to keep it makes the process go much faster 😊)**
- **A state certified birth certificate** (If the child was born in the state of TN, the birth certificate can be obtained from the Health Dept. or from the state website. There is usually some difficulty obtaining doctor appointment and birth certificates at the last minute, so we encourage parents to plan ahead for these needs.)
- **Proof of residence in Loudon County** We need three items. (1.) Utility bill or similar bill (2.) Renter's agreement or property tax notice (3.) Guardian's state issued identification with the same address as proof # 1 and #2.
- If the child is already 4 for Pre-K or 5 for K they will need to bring their **immunization record and medical examination/physical papers**. The medical exam/physical papers can be obtained at the child's pediatrician's office.
