District Goals

2018 – 2019

- Grades 3 – 8 Reading Language Arts Goal:** For the 2018 - 2019 school year, the district will have 32% of students in grade 3 - 5 scoring on-track (proficient) and mastered (advanced) in Reading/Language Arts. For the 2018 - 2019 school year, the district will have 34.3% of students in grade 6 - 8 scoring on-track (proficient) and mastered (advanced) in Reading/Language Arts.
- Grades 3 – 8 Mathematics Goal:** For the 2018 - 2019 school year, the district will have 40.4% of students in grade 3 - 5 scoring on-track (proficient) and mastered (advanced) in Mathematics. For the 2018 - 2019 school year, the district will have 42.2% of students in grade 6 - 8 scoring on-track (proficient) and mastered (advanced) in Mathematics.
- Graduation Readiness Goal:** Greene County's ACT composite score for the 2018-2019 school year improve to 19.2 on the ACT composite. By 2020, the school system's ACT average will be at 21. For the 2018-2019 School Year, Greene County will improve the number of students engaged in post-secondary opportunities by 2%. In the 2018 - 2019 school year, Greene County will improve the Mathematics mastered and on-track scores to 23.6%.
- Safe And Healthy Student Goal** For 2018 - 2019, students will have equal access to a safe learning environment that promotes academic achievement, limits the amount of lost instructional time and ensures that all students have the opportunity to learn. For 2018 - 2019, Greene County will reduce the percentage of students reported as chronically absent to 9.8%.
- Kindergarten through 2nd grade Goal:** For the 2018 - 2019 school year, the district will have 30% of students on the second grade TNReady assessment scoring on-track (proficient) and mastered (advanced) in Reading/Language Arts. For the 2018 - 2019 school year, the district will have 40% of students on the second grade TNReady assessment scoring on-track (proficient) and mastered (advanced) in Mathematics.
