

Dear parents,

We wanted to inform you of a few changes for the upcoming book fair in February (4th-7th). We are making these changes to ensure that the fair runs smoothly with minimal classroom interruption and money stays with the student who brought it. We hope that you understand these changes and continue to support our fair the same amazing way you have in the past.

Students will be going by grade level to the fair on a designated day with their teachers. It is important that if they want to shop at the fair, they bring their money on the day assigned to that grade level. The schedule is as follows:

Monday: all students will have a chance to walk through and make a wish list, no purchases

Tuesday: Third grade and Fourth grade

Wednesday: Kindergarten, First grade, and Mrs. Hall

Thursday: Second grade, Fifth grade, and Mrs. Velasco

You are more than welcome to come shop with your child, but it will only be on the day that you would be scheduled to eat lunch with them. Come eat lunch and then shop during your child's playground time. This is so students are missing minimal instruction time.

We will have Thursday evening available for you and your child, along with any other family members, to come shop the fair. We understand that not everyone can take off work during the day, so we wanted to give you the opportunity to come shop. We will be open from 5:30 – 6:30 that evening.

Did you know we have an online fair? If you are unable to make it to the fair, this is a great way to shop. There are no additional fees and the books are delivered to the school about two weeks after the fair closes. Grandparents or aunts and uncles who do not live close can also shop the fair online.
