

# Summer Assignments 2019

## World Language III Honors and IV Honors

**Spanish III and Italian III:** Self portrait- Write a 100 words composition about yourself in the target language. Include favorite color, hobbies, TV shows, etc. Sentences need to be grammatically correct in the present tense, including irregular verbs. Sentences must be **challenging**, not too basic. Include a collage of at least 10 pictures. You will also need to do a mini presentation in front of the class the first week of school.

**Spanish IV and Italian IV:** Select **ONE** of the following:

1. Create a **children's storybook** in the target language. Use vocabulary recently learned. The story should be 150-200 words and contain at least five illustrated pages. You will read the story to the class and explain any words students might not know.
2. Make up a **story** in the target language. The story should be at least 150-200 words. Make an illustrated PowerPoint/Google slides Presentation of at least 10 slides. You will present in class and explain any words students might not know.
3. Create a **picture collage** of things you did during the summer vacation, it can be fictional. At least 10 pictures on Scrapbook size paper. You are to use the **past tense or past progressive tense**. Be creative. The sentences should be on a separate sheet of paper (typed) (150-200) words. Sentences should be challenging, not too basic. You will also need to do a mini presentation in front of the class on the due date.

Your projects will be graded on the following categories:

- **Content:** overall presentation of the required information. 25%
- **Accuracy:** Proper grammar and spelling. 25%
- **Neatness/Creativity:** Overall appearance of the project. 15%
- **Completeness:** All content included and **on time**. 10%
- **Oral presentation** 25%
