

DRUG AND ALCOHOL TESTING FOR SCHOOL BUS DRIVERS

Controlled Substance and Alcohol Abuse

The Board of Education desires to take all possible steps to ensure transportation safety for District students and staff. The Superintendent or designee shall establish a drug and alcohol testing program for all school bus drivers and any other employees who hold a commercial driver's license which is necessary to perform duties related to their employment with the District. This program shall be designed to fulfill the requirements of federal law and regulations.

Drivers who test positive for alcohol or drugs shall be removed from safety-sensitive functions and subject to disciplinary action up to and including dismissal in accordance with administrative regulations.
